

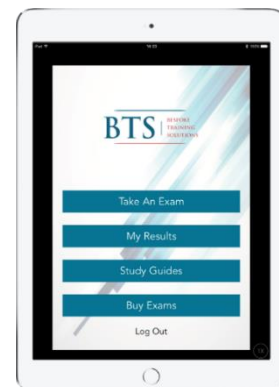
# Bespoke Training Solutions: R0 Study Buddy

**BTS R0 StudyBuddy provides a new way of practicing for the Chartered Insurance Institute R0 exams, increasing your chances of passing a Diploma in Regulated Financial Planning exam (R0 exam) at the first sitting.**

**With enough sample exam-style questions for four full exams, BTS StudyBuddy is perfect for anyone trying to pass R01 through to R05.**

## Features

- Replicates the CII exam standard, as much as possible, in an electronic format
- Able to mirror the time pressure that you experience in the real exam
- Includes challenging question styles, such as confusing or unclear language and grammar, and double-negatives
- Includes questions that appear to have more than one correct answer but are not multi-response
- Includes questions that appear to have no correct answer
  - Allows you to choose the exam you sit
    - Complete full specimen exams
    - Focus on specific Learning Outcomes
  - Marks the paper for you: no need to cross check with an answer grid
  - Provides feedback on what you got right and wrong, and WHY!
  - Highlights areas that require further development
  - Allows you to practice as and when you have time
  - Complements other BTS R0 support, such as Study Guides and Workshops

## So, how does Study Buddy work?

Using R03 as an example...

- Once you've bought a 'set' (for £29.99) you'd get 200 questions.
- From there, when you ask the App to create a full sample exam, it grabs 50 questions and creates a full paper. The questions would be structured, so that the sample paper you get matches the syllabus split in a real exam.
- The next time you ask the App to create a full sample exam it will create another new paper based on 50 syllabus-specific questions. You may get some of the same questions but you may not. There are enough questions in any one bank for 4 full exams with no repeated questions.
- In practice, you could ask the App to create around 50 full sample exam papers before you'd get one with exactly the same questions as any of the previous 49! The logic is, each time you try a paper you will get some questions you've seen before (so consolidate your learning) and some new ones.
- You can also ask the app to 'Just give me questions on Learning outcome 'x', to focus your revision. This gives you a better chance of practicing all the questions in the 'set'.
